## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided thereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

<b>DOGS COMPETING*</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3 to 5</b>	<b>6 to 9</b>	<b>10 to 12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>
<b>POINTS AWARDED</b>	<b>0</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>5</b>

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly (a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points) for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the recorded of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) (3) Must have received at least a 2 pt win from the Breed or Group Level.

## PLEASE COMPLETE ONE ENTRY FORM PER DOG, PER CLASS (e.g. ONE FORM FOR OPEN B AND ANOTHER FOR UTILITY)

**Note:** No entry will be accepted without entry fees. Tendering of an NSF cheque shall be considered **NON-PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES** and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellations of awards by the **CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB**. Charges for any **NSF cheques** or **declined VISA/MC numbers** issued to The Working-Herding Dog Association of Alberta will be \$25.00. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. **OVERPAYMENT** of entry fees **WILL NOT** be refunded. To comply with CKC, no entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled, or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries (except as provided for in Chapter 13, Section 13.4 of the Dog Show Rules). Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted except in the event of a postal strike. Please contact one of the following in that event.

All entries must be typed or distinctly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. The Working Herding Dog Association of Alberta does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information on an entry form due to illegibility of information submitted by the owner or owner's agent or entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to enter.

## Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Funds. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. We recommend the purchase of Bank Drafts or Money Orders, etc. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Post dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you

## General Information & Rules

1. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by act of the show/trial committee or because it has been entered incorrectly ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED (AFTER THE CLOSING DATE), except as provided for in "2" below. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of The Working Herding Dog Association of Alberta, it is impossible to open or complete the show, NO REFUND of entry fees will be made.
2. Any female entered in the OBEDIENCE trials who, because of being in season, cannot compete will have the entry fee refunded. A VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 days preceding the trial) must be delivered to the Show/Trial Secretary PRIOR to the commencement of that trial's judging. This does not apply to the Specialty show, as this condition is not a disqualification in conformation.
3. The official veterinarian is "ON CALL". Anyone who wishes to have his service should approach the Show Superintendent who will arrange for the veterinarian's attendance. Please note that any charge for this service will be met by the person requesting the veterinarian's service.
4. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show/trial which will be governed by CKC rules.
5. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour prior to the scheduled judging of their breed. Dogs which are not required for further judging may be excused.
6. Dogs must be ready for judging. The club and its superintendent will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class or group. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring.
7. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
8. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
9. Dogs and children must be under control at all times.
10. Entries will be acknowledged after the closing date - judging schedule and receipt will be mailed.
11. DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Persons exercising dogs outside of the designated area who make no effort to clean-up may be disqualified from that day's show/trial.
12. No dogs will be allowed on the show site unless entered in the show or trial or entered in exhibition only.
13. The show building will open at 7:00 AM, Saturday October 8, 2005
14. Mail early to avoid delay in the mail, if you are late, use a courier service. If using Greyhound, make sure you use a large envelope, as we have had several cases of small envelopes being lost.
15. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred" (See Section 26.7)
16. IN TRANSIT STICKERS will be available at the Show Secretary Table.
17. **NO DOGS IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT !!!!! NO EXCEPTIONS**
18. Any ENTRY may be withdrawn PRIOR to the date and time of closing of entries by phone, provided that withdrawal of entry IN WRITING is received by the Show Secretary within 7 days after closing. Entries withdrawn by phone, but not confirmed in writing within the allowable time will be considered as valid and appear in the Show Catalogue, in which case, fees will not be refunded.
19. **ALL DOGS MUST BE UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.** If not in competition the dog must be on a minimum 6 foot leash and collar or appropriately confined in the benching area. Also see CKC Obedience Rule 6-1-20

### ERN Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at:

## C L A S S I F I C A T I O N S :

**Specialty** - the following CKC official classes divided by sex, will be provided for all breeds in groups 3 &

**Junior Puppy** 6 months but under 9 months on the day of the show  
**Senior Puppy** 9 months but under 12 months on the day of the show  
**Yearling** 12 months but under 18 months on the day of the show  
**Canadian Bred** for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded  
**Bred by Exhibitor** for dogs owned and handled by the breeder  
**Open** for all dogs  
**Veterans** for dogs over seven years of age on the day of the show, these dogs compete for regular placements, and the first place dog will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The Winner of the veterans class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs/Bitches in this class **ONLY may be neutered or spayed**

**Specials Only** dogs which are registered individually in the records of the CKC or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "Listed dog" in this class is NOT allowed, except for foreign born miniature dachshunds under one year of age.

**Moving a Dog to Specials** a dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with CKC rules, but at the time of entry closing has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from regular class to SPECIAL ONLY provided the transfer is submitted in writing to the Show/Trial secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR to the opening of the show.

**Obedience Trial** - the following official/unofficial classes will be provided for all breeds.

**Novice A** for any purebred dog that has not won the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its U.D. (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere, shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

**Novice B** for any purebred dog that has not won the title C.D. (Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "sit" and "down" exercises. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for entry in this class.

**Open A** for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada, but that has not won the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its U.D. (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which as won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

**Open B** for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "sit" and "down" exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has won the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs that have won the title of U.D. may enter this class. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility class is also eligible for entry in the Open B class at the same trial.

**Utility** for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D.X. in Canada. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "group examination" exercise.

**Veterans** the Veteran Class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may not be entered in any regular (obedience) class.

**Brace** is open to any 2 dogs of any breed and of either sex which have attained not less than a CD in Canada. It is NOT necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be the same breed. This class is judged in the same manner as the Novice Class.

**Novice C** see CKC rules 13 Transition Classes

**Pre-Novice** see CKC rules 13 Transition Classes

**Novice Intermediate** see CKC rules 13 Transition Classes
